Dear Dr. McRae:

I am very glad to enclose a formal acknowledgment of your order for the Scott Philharmonic receiver covered by the enclosed invoice.

Herewith I am enclosing our regular conditional sales contract. Kindly sign all copies and return them to us. As soon as our Credit Department has approved your credit, we will sign and return your copy for your files. We will also date the contract at the same time.

You, of course, know that every Scott receiver is custombuilt to order. You can be assured your receiver will be thoroughly tested and absolutely perfect in every respect before it leaves the laboratories.

You cannot use the same speakers with the Scott Philharmonic receiver that you are using with your present 23-tube model. Furthermore, inasmuch as these speakers are different the extension cable is also different. Accordingly, I have taken the liberty of entering an order for a new cable the invoice for which is enclosed.

It is true that your present speakers have a frequency range of from 30 to 16,000 cycles. This is the same range that is covered by the Philharmonic receiver, but inasmuch as the speakers are entirely different you cannot use the same speakers with the new receiver.

We will notify you a few days before shipment. You can then make arrangements to dis-assemble your present receiver and turn it over to the Express Agent upon delivery of the new Philharmonic.

At the present time you are using a regular Super Antenna. The new Super Double Doublet Antenna is entirely different as you will note from the enclosed folder. Frankly, Dr. McRae, it would be my recommendation that you purchase the new antenna in order to secure maximum results. If you

continue to use your present Double Doublet Antenna it will be necessary for you to hook it up as a single wire antenna when the receiver arrives. While this arrangement will give you entirely satisfactory results, for maximum performance you should really have the Scott Super Double Doublet.

I am enclosing an Instruction Manual so that you may have the opportunity of studying the installation and the controls so that you may become familiar with the receiver before arrival of the set.

In closing, I would like to take this opportunity of wishing you many years of pleasure from your Scott receiver, and I will be very glad to hear from you, from time to time, regarding your reception.
